



LMMR currently exists on 17 acres of borrowed property in San Angelo, TX. The property is owned by Peaceful Valley Donkey Rescue, Inc. This is a temporary arrangement until LMMR can afford to purchase a suitable permanent location.

CRITERIA FOR FUTURE LMMR FACILITY

PHYSICAL CRITERIA

- 20-200 acres (ideally more acreage for sanctuary mules)
 - Water, sewage and electricity set up
 - Perimeter fence is ideal
 - Does not have to be cross-fenced
- Must have no restrictions to number of animals per acre
 - No restrictions for mobile homes

BUILDING LIST (DOES NOT HAVE TO BE PRESENT CURRENTLY ON LAND)

- Welcome/visitor center/office
- Quarantine/medical barn
- Covered training area
- Feed and equipment barn (Immediate need)
- Onsite temporary housing for volunteers, farriers, dentists, etc.
- Onsite permanent housing for 2 employees (Immediate need)
 - Shelters (Immediate need)

EQUIPMENT LIST

- Bucket tractor (owned)
 - Round bale tractor
 - Spreader
 - Dump truck/trailer
 - ATV
- Pickup truck (Immediate need)
- Stock trailer (Immediate need)
 - Chute (Immediate need)
- Tilt chute (Immediate need)

GEOGRAPHIC CRITERIA

- Within or 30 minutes from Waco/Dallas (population 100,000+) for ease of hiring, tourism and volunteerism
 - Within reasonable driving distance of a prominent equine veterinary hospital
 - Perimeter fencing cannot back up to any high-traffic highways
